Location: The Annual Meeting of the SREB Council on Collegiate Education for Nursing will be held at the **JW Marriott Hotel Buckhead** (3300 Lenox Road N.E.) in the heart of Atlanta's Buckhead community. The hotel is connected by an enclosed promenade to the shopping and dining areas of Lenox Square Mall.

- A MARTA subway station (<http://www.itsmarta.com>) is across the street from the hotel and provides convenient access to and from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport and many other major attractions in Atlanta.
- Taxi service is available outside the hotel 24 hours/day. The cost is a minimum of \$7 around Buckhead and \$46 to the airport. Prices vary according to the number of passengers.
- An airport shuttle, Atlanta Link (<http://www.theatlantalink.com>), picks up passengers on the hour. See the website for specific hours of operation. The cost is \$20.50 (one way) and \$37 roundtrip.
